

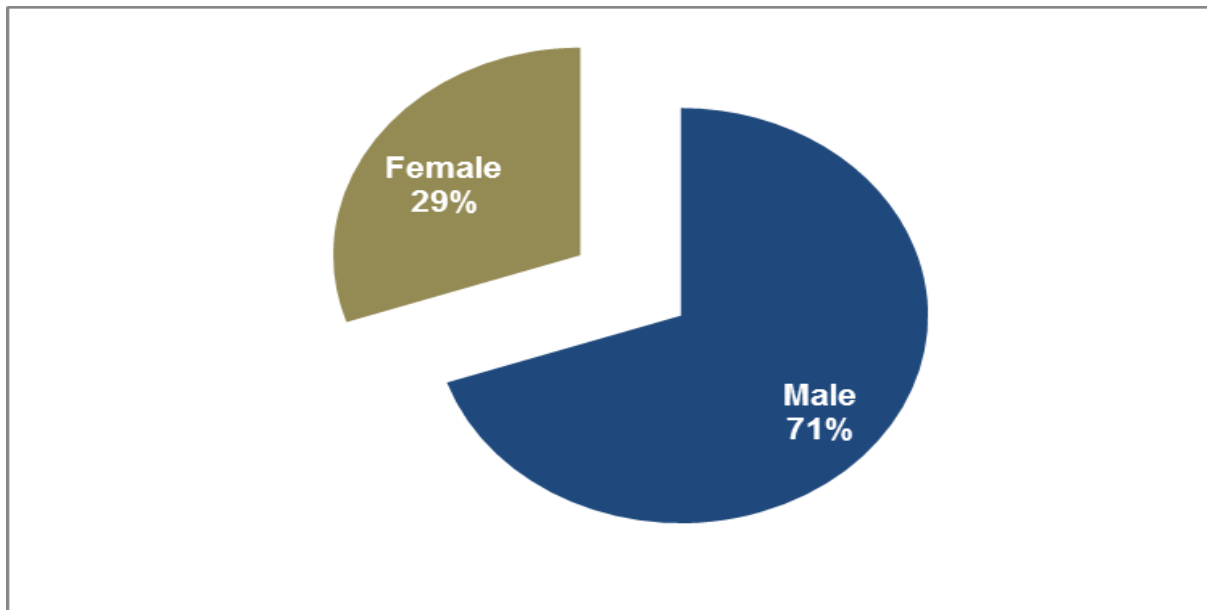
I. JETHRO-LMI SO FAR (AS OF JUNE, 2015)

1.1. INTERNATIONAL QUALIFICATION PROGRAMS

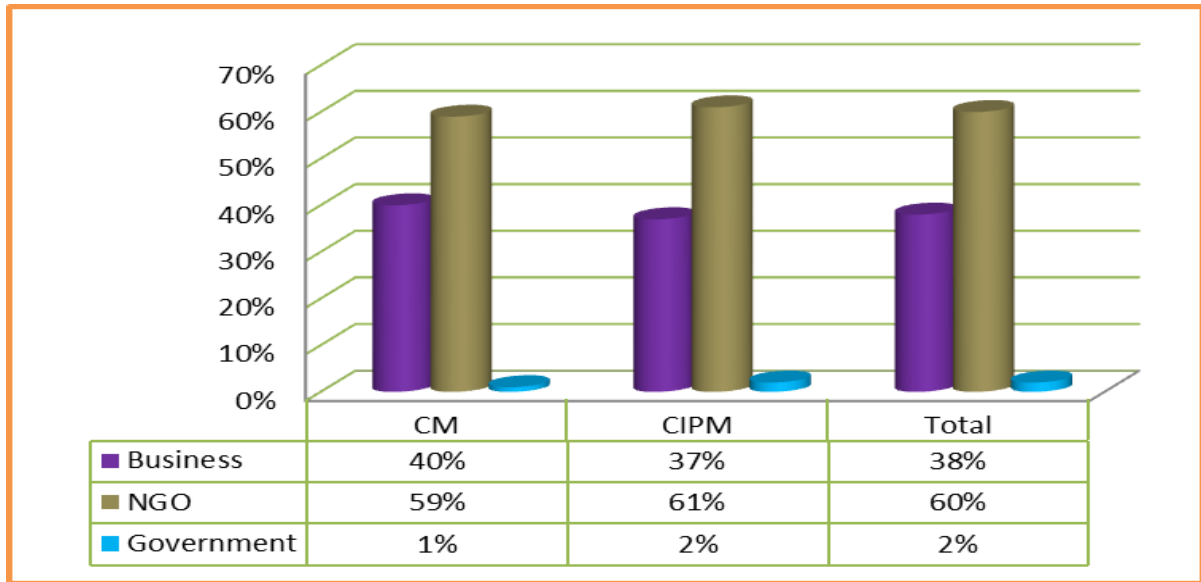
Certified professionals segregated by Sex

Certified Professionals by Sector



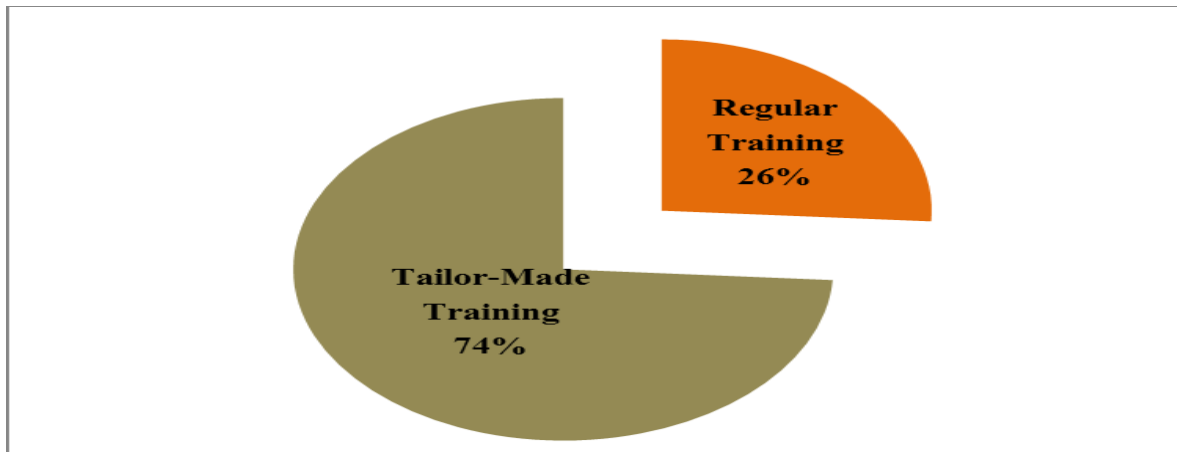

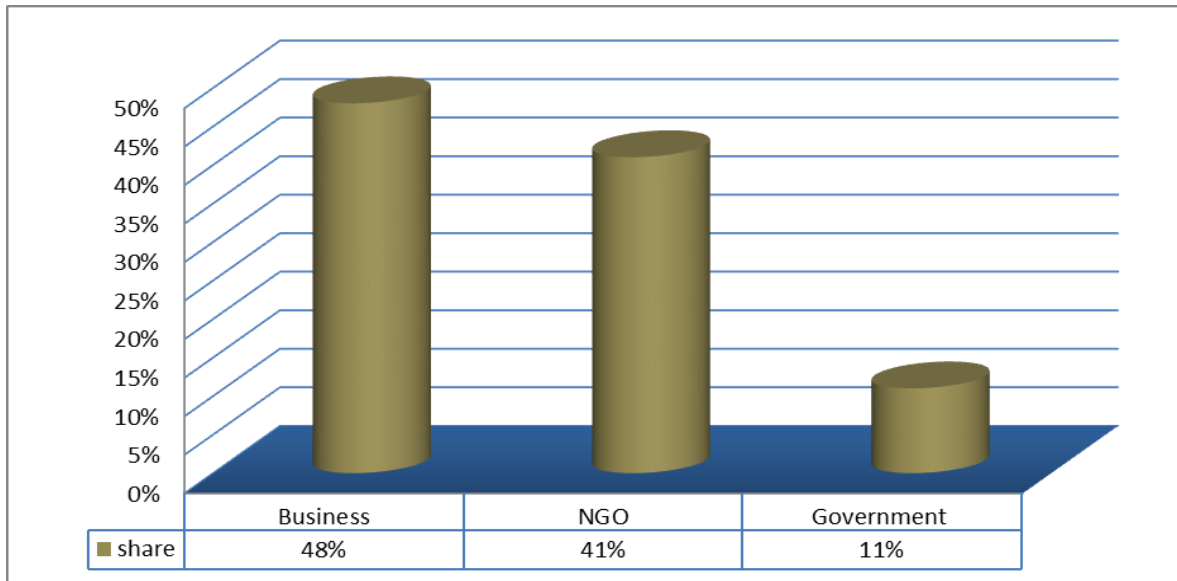
1.2. SHORT-TERM TRAINING
